

The Department of Oriental Languages announces a position as **Postdoctoral Associate in Asian languages and cultures** (ref no SU 619-0930-10)

Subject Description

Asian languages and cultures

Assignments

The Postdoctoral Associate is primarily a research appointment. Furthermore, 20% of the position is assigned to university teaching at basic and advanced levels.

Qualifications

The minimum qualification for this position is a doctoral degree or its academic equivalent. The degree shall have been awarded no later than the closing date for application to the position. Applicants who have received their degree no more than three years prior to the close of the application period will be given priority. Applicants who have completed their degree earlier than this will be considered if there are special reasons warranting their inclusions. Such reasons include sickness, national service, a position of responsibility within a trade union or student organisation, maternity/paternity leave or other similar circumstances. The appointment is renewable up to a maximum of four years.

For the present post doc position the doctoral degree should be in a subject that falls under the subject position above, for instance Central Asian studies, Indology, Japanology, Korean studies or Sinology. Alternatively, the doctoral degree may be in another subject, if the doctoral dissertation is consonant with the subject description, and the applicant has studied some Asian language at at least master (one-year) level

Terms of employment

The position is located at the Department of Oriental Languages at Stockholm University. It is a full-time position that holds for two years. If there are special reasons this period might be extended. The person appointed is expected to start on **September 1, 2010**, unless otherwise agreed.

Assessment criteria

Special weight will be given to scientific quality as demonstrated by own research. The applicant's research plan will also be of great importance.

Application

The following documents must be submitted

1. the applicant's CV and list of qualifications.
2. a copy of the doctoral degree certificate)
3. a statement (not more than 5 pages) of the applicant's research plan as a postdoctoral associate
4. a selection of not more than three scientific publications
