Trier is located in (South)West Germany. The closest airports are:

## Airport Frankfurt-Hahn (HHN) [Ryanair]

There is a direct bus connection from Frankfurt-Hahn airport to Trier main station. The shuttle operates seven times a day. A one-way ticket costs 12 € per person and the trip takes approx. 80 minutes. More detailed information can be found on the website of the <u>bus-company</u>.

## Airport Luxembourg (LUX)

- The airport in Luxembourg is not affiliated to the German Railway Network. There are regular busses in order to reach a town with a train station. The bus connections can be found at the website of <u>Deutsche Bahn</u> (from: Luxembourg Airport, to: Trier Hbf).
- An airport liner operates between the airport Luxembourg and Trier. A one-way ticket costs 13,50 € per person and the journey takes approx. 45 minutes. Further infomation can be found on the <u>airport-liner website</u>. Reservations are required.

## Airport Saarbrücken (SCN)

• The airport Saarbrücken is not affiliated to the German Railway Network. You can either go by bus (regional bus line 10, journey time approx. 30 minutes) or by taxi (journey time approx. 20 minutes) from the airport Saarbrücken to Saarbrücken main station. From there trains to Trier main station leave regularly. The schedules can be found on the website of the <u>Deutsche Bahn</u>. The journey takes between 60 and 90 minutes, depending on the train connection

Frankfurt (FRA) (for train connections see Deutsche Bahn.)

Cologne / Bonn (CGN) (for train connections see Deutsche Bahn.)

Zweibrücken (ZQW) (for train connections see Deutsche Bahn.)

From Trier main station to our meeting place (Stadtbibliothek) it takes a comfortable walk of about 20 - 30 minutes. Another 10 minutes are needed to walk from the Stadtbibliothek to the hotel.
