WORK PLACEMENTS with ERASMUS+

UK Visa information sheet

• The ERASMUS+ programme is continuing as usual until 2022 so you can receive a stipend to help cover the costs of doing a work placement abroad

If you are going to do a work placement in the UK:

- A "Temporary Worker Government Authorised Exchange visa (T5) (subtype: Migrant CESC)" visa is required to do work placements in the UK according to the post Brexit immigration laws.

- To apply for this visa, you will need
 - o a passport (not just an ID card!)
 - a "certificate of sponsorship" (CoS) for your VISA application the colleagues at the ERASMUS Praktika office will assist you with this once they have received your paperwork as ERASMUS is your sponsor
 - a biometric residence permit (you'll probably have to go to Munich, Düsseldorf or Berlin to let them take your fingerprints, etc.) see here: https://www.gov.uk/government-authorised-exchange/apply
- Note that biometrics and the CoS cannot be done more than 3 months before you apply for the visa - as soon as you've got those, you can apply for the visa.
- The visa application costs 189 GBP, there will be no health surcharge for you, if you hold a German/EU passport
- You may be asked to prove that you have a certain amount of money in your bank account to support yourself while you are in the UK (~1000€), depending on what the CoS says
- An official language test is usually not required as you are studying English at University.

KEY STEPS:

- Arrange the work placement and complete the Learning Agreement
- Get a passport
- Submit ERASMUS+ paperwork (online application, LA, etc.) as detailed here: https://erasmuspraktika.de/bewerbung/
- Let the colleagues at your host institution in the UK know that you'll be applying for a visa three months before the start of your placement
- Let the colleagues in the Erasmus+ office know that you need a CoS to apply for a visa
