Class description

In this advanced integrated-skills ELT / EAP class, speaking and listening skills are trained which are essential for students' academic studies of English. Teachers focus on a range of useful language areas and study skills, such as giving academic presentations, taking notes in lectures, reporting/summarising journal articles, debating and discussing controversial issues. Detailed individual feedback is given to students on their language accuracy and fluency, as well as guidance for self-study and skills development.
