² Students who started their Bachelor's before WS13/14 and still need to take both the old Lang 101 and Lang 201 can take ONE new Lang 101 - the number of credit points suffices for both of the 'old' classes.

³ From WS13/14 Master's level classes are only offered according to the new rules.

⁴ LANG 402 Professional Writing will be offered in SS2014 and then again from SS2016. Students who do not complete the class in SS2014 will have to wait two years to take this class.

⁵ *Schriftliche Kompetenz* will continue to be listed under this name until SS2014. From WS14/15 students who still need to take the class should discuss an individual solution with any member of Sprachpraxis.

⁶ From SS2014 students must take Lang 1001, as *Übersetzung II* will cease to be offered separately.

⁷ *Integrated Skills / Klausurenkurs* will continue to be listed under this name until SS2015. From WS15/16 students must take Lang 1001, as *Integrated Skills / Klausurenkurs* will cease to be offered separately.
