

Job advertisement: Freelance English / EAP Instructor

Trier University's Department of English Studies is interested in receiving CVs from potential freelance teachers for 1-3 advanced EFL/EAP classes to start at the beginning of either summer term (April) or winter term (October).

Class descriptions

We are interested in finding freelance teachers who can teach:

LANG 101 Integrated Language and Study Skills, which trains speaking and listening skills for students' academic studies of English at the B2+ level, with a focus on oral presentations.

and/or *LANG 301 / 401 Cultural Studies*, which provides an overview understanding of the society and culture of one inner-circle English-speaking country, usually the UK, the USA, Ireland, or Canada, whilst honing students' C1-level language skills.

and/or *LANG 601 Special Topic in Language Skills*, which concentrates on a specialised area of language usage at the C1-C2 level, e.g. translation, creative writing, business communication, discussion/debate, depending on instructors' areas of expertise.

Job Details

This is a freelance position, teaching a maximum of three classes per week.

Each class has around 25 students and meets for 90 minutes per week, in person at the university, for a 15-week semester (April – July or October – February). The payment is €54 for 90 minutes, paid in a lump sum after the end of the semester. We are sadly not able to reimburse any other costs (e.g. travel expenses).

- Bachelor's degree; language-related
- expert proficiency in English
- first-hand experience of life in an English-speaking country
- right to work in Germany

Ideal:

- teaching qualification; preferably TEFL/TESOL
- relevant EAP experience
- good knowledge of German
