

Job advertisement: Freelance English Instructor with expertise in teaching young learners

Trier University's English Studies Language Team is interested in receiving CVs from potential freelance teachers for 1-3 EFL classes per semester. We are specifically looking for a freelance teacher who can teach a language class for students in a BEd programme training to be primary school teachers.

Our classes start in October for winter semester and April for summer semester. We are looking for someone to start teaching with us in April 2023. Final decisions on teaching staff and timetabling will be made in February 2023.

Class description

The class aims to be a crash course in the English language needed for the primary school classroom, with a strong emphasis on spoken English and pronunciation. The participants are BEd students with B2+ level English. The work students complete for this class includes oral assessments, regular homework, and a reflective learning journal.

Job Details

This is a freelance position, teaching a maximum of three classes per week.

Each class has around 25 students and meets for 90 minutes per week, in person at the university, for a 15-week semester (April – July or October – February). The payment is €54 for 90 minutes, paid in a lump sum after the end of the semester. We are sadly not able to reimburse any other costs (e.g travel expenses).

Person Specification

Suitable candidates will have:

- the right to work in Germany
- expert proficiency in English
- relevant Bachelor's degree (languages or education)
- relevant experience/expertise in teaching English to young learners

Also desirable:

- first-hand experience of life in an English-speaking country
- TEFL/TESOL qualification
- knowledge of German
