Call for Abstracts

The aim of the workshop is to discuss different ways of teaching Taiwan studies through digital means. Given the social and cultural diversity of the student population, how to better track and support individual learning progress is becoming a major challenge in schools today. Digital media and learning infrastructures allow for more personalised learning in many ways. The key is to provide an appropriate level of learning content that promotes long-term learning interest and effectiveness. However, with increasingly sophisticated tools for data processing, how do we create appropriate applications in various fields of Taiwan studies? To see more scalability and opportunities, we invite research abstracts on digital experiences and formats, including but not limited to:

-Digital tools and techniques

(Databases/Information technology applied to teaching/Artificial intelligence in education)

-Distance learning

(Massive Open Online Courses/ Virtual School/ Online Learning)

- Interactive learning in different areas

(e-learning platforms / museums / libraries / exhibitions / universities / schools)

*Case studies in political science, anthropology, literature and history are most welcome.

All abstracts must be submitted (and presented) in English. Abstracts submitted for consideration must be an original idea and concept. The final selection will be made by the TAP Committee, which will also determine the format and schedule for the presentation of each abstract. Grant recipients will be selected on the basis of the points awarded to their abstracts. Each presenter will give a 20-minute presentation followed by a 10-minute discussion in this workshop.

Travel expenses and accommodation will be covered by TAP:

Participants from Germany (travel fees up to 200 EUR and four nights at 80 EUR)

Participants from Europe (travel fees up to 500 EUR and four nights at 80 EUR)

Participants from Asia (travel fees up to 1,400 EUR and four nights at 80 EUR)
