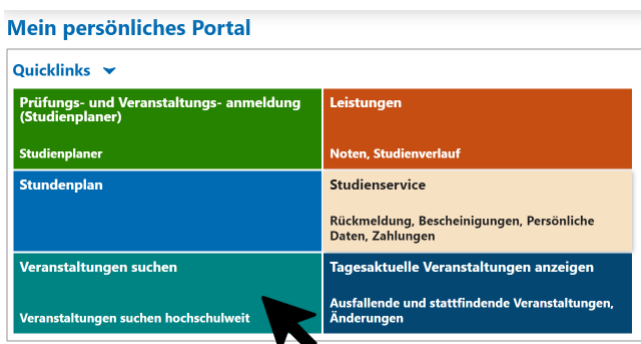

## How to find a course

Here, we translated the titles of the courses into English, so you can get a better overview. However, on Porta the titles of German courses will be written in German. Therefore, you may find the *German title in cursive beneath every course information as well as the course number* which you can simply copy-paste to find your chosen courses in Porta. The number is the easiest way to find a course.

## Course Information

Most courses are given in German and therefore, are not specifically marked. Courses taught in English are **marked accordingly**.

Last update: 01.10.2023. The information in this document is preliminary and might be subject to change!

**ERASMUS:** First, we offer an **ERASMUS Module** each winter semester that encompasses the most crucial issues on the Political System of the Federal Republic of Germany. This consists of one lecture taught in German which you will attend together with German students, and one **tutorial exclusively designed for ERASMUS students in English**.

**Lectures** (2 hours weekly) are offered on several topics. You can receive 5 ECTS if you pass an **oral or written exam**. Some lectures are combined with a **tutorial**.

**Seminars** in **Basic Modules** (2 hours weekly) are classes for beginners, e.g., for students in their first or second year. In order to obtain a grade, it is usually necessary to give a presentation and write a seminar paper. You can receive 5 ECTS for a Seminar in a Basic Module.

In Seminars of **Advanced Modules** or **Master Courses** (4 hours weekly), you can receive 10 ECTS. Usually, it is necessary to give a presentation and to write a seminar paper or pass an oral exam. Many of those courses are taught in English.

**IMPORTANT:** Attendance in seminars is compulsory. You will only be allowed to the testing procedure if you did not miss the class more than two or three times.

### Special testing conditions

Under consultation with the respective lecturer and dependent on the individual language level, it is possible to write seminar papers in English or take oral exams instead of written exams. Those special conditions must be agreed on with the lecturer.
