Course Information

Most courses are held in German. Courses taught in English are **marked accordingly**.

Last update: 2 March 2022. The information in this document is preliminary and might be subject to change!

How to find a course

First and foremost, we offer an **ERASMUS Module** in the winter semester which encompasses the most crucial issues on the Political System of the FRG.

Lectures (2 hours weekly) are offered on several topics. You can receive 5 ECTS if you pass an oral or written exam. Some lectures are combined with a **tutorial**.

Seminars in **Basic Modules** (2 hours weekly) are classes for beginners, e.g. for students in their first or second year. In order to obtain a grade it is usually necessary to give a presentation and to write a seminar paper. You can receive 5 ECTS for a Seminar in a Basic Module.

In **Seminars** of **Advanced Modules** or **Master Courses** (4 hours weekly), you can receive 10 ECTS. Usually it is necessary to give a presentation and to write a seminar paper or pass an oral exam.

IMPORTANT: Attendance in seminars is compulsory. You will only be allowed to the testing procedure if you did not miss the class more than two or three times.
