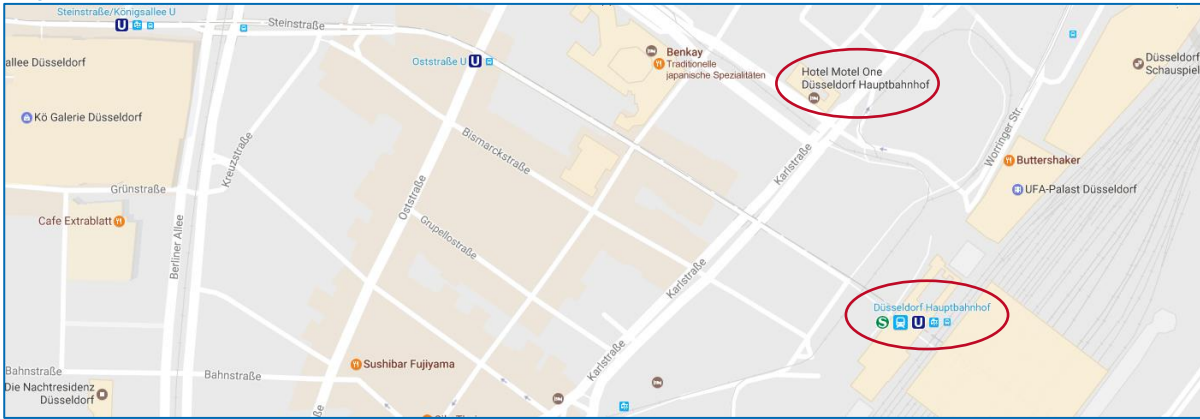

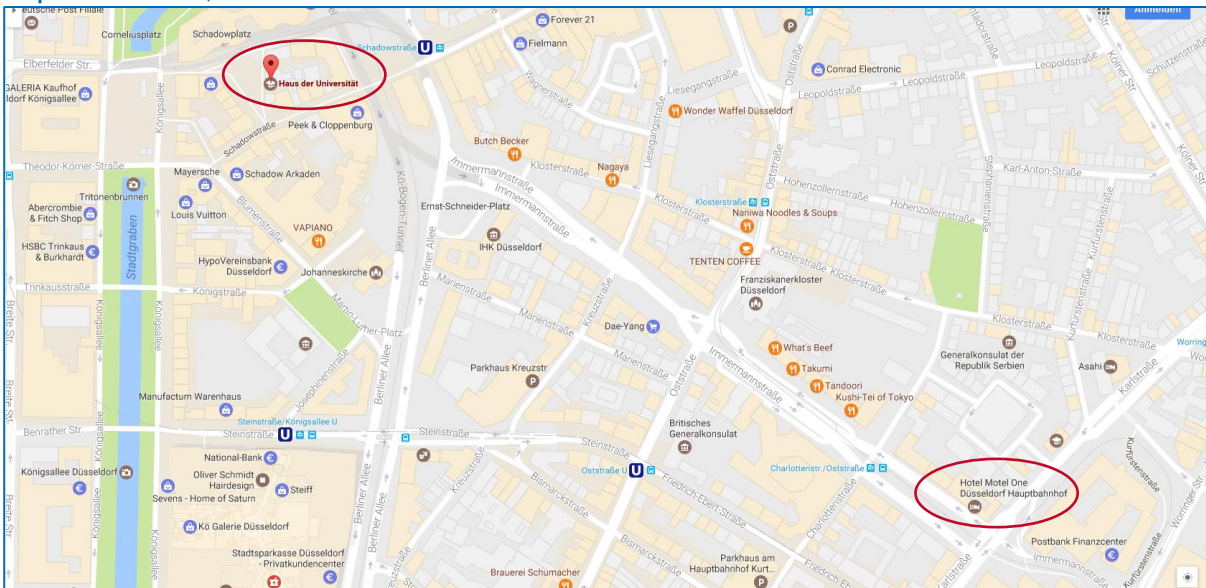


Map 1: Central Station, Motel One



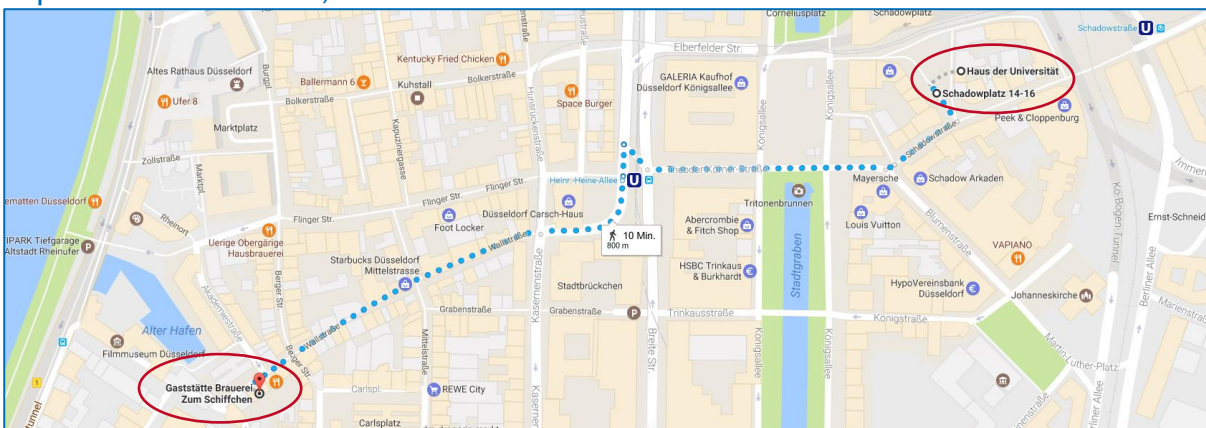
(Walking Distance: approx. 5 mins / 0.3 km)
