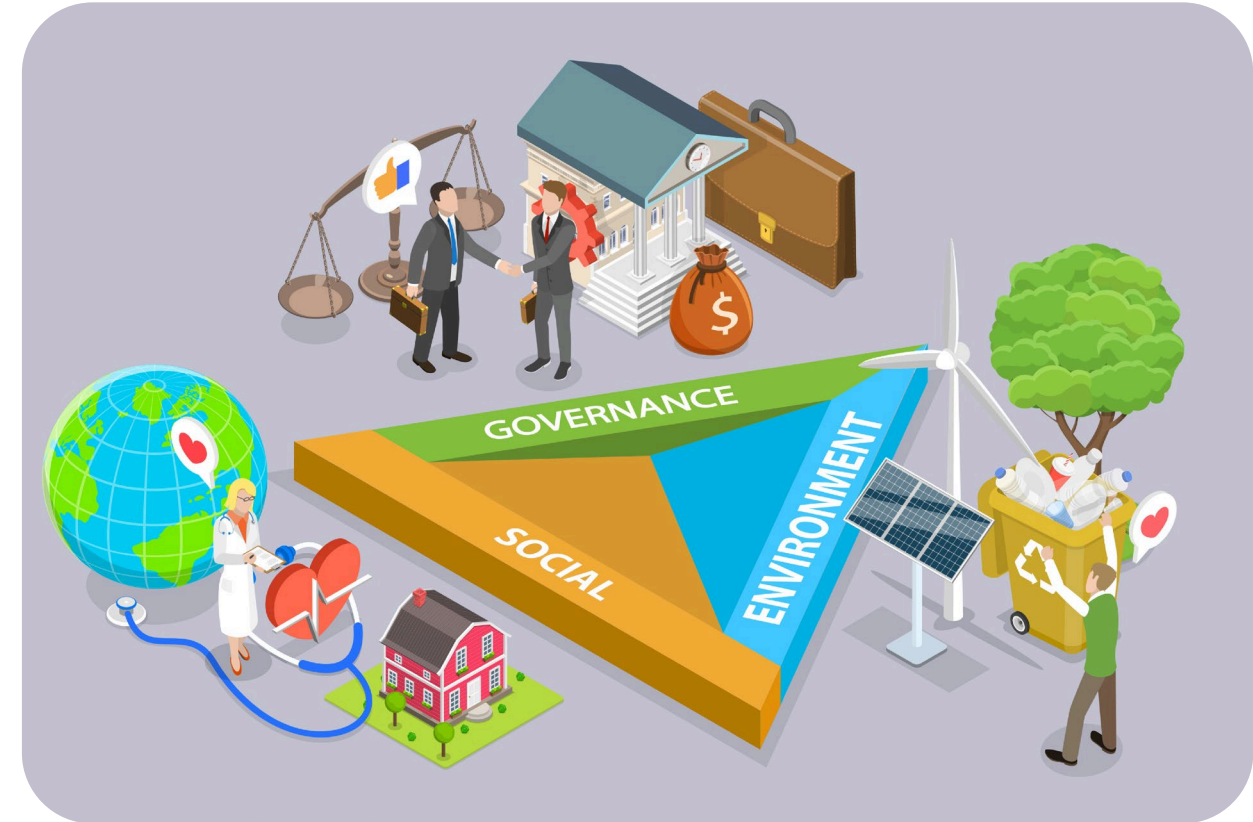

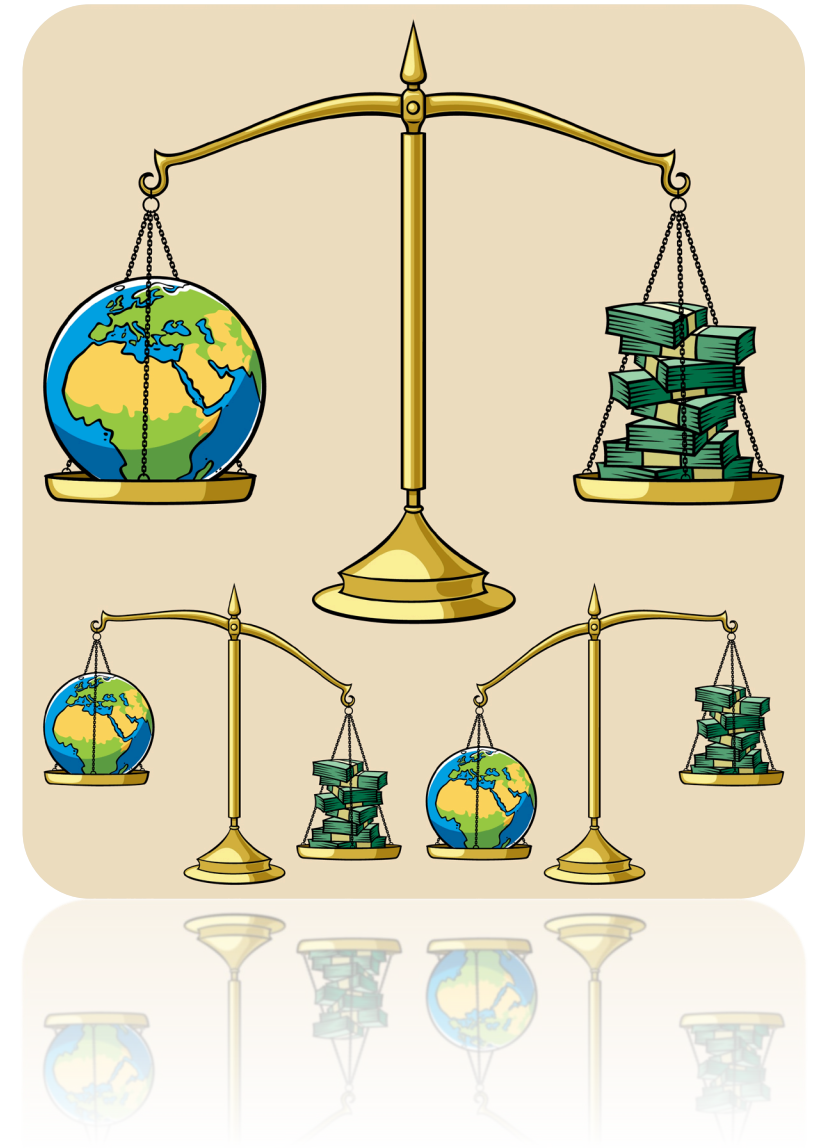
Why you should study SM&E

- Wide range of **specializations** and elective courses



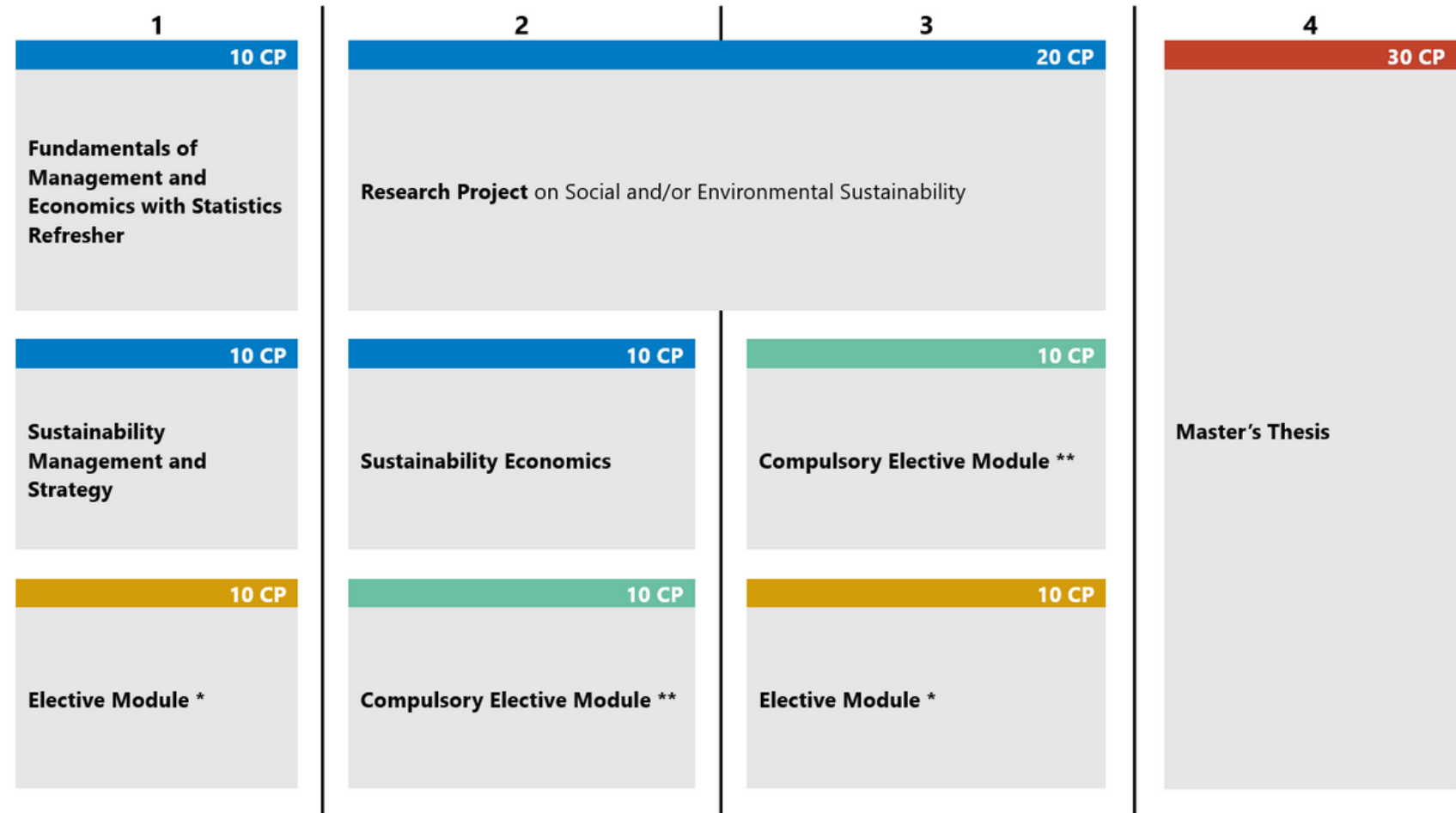
Prerequisites

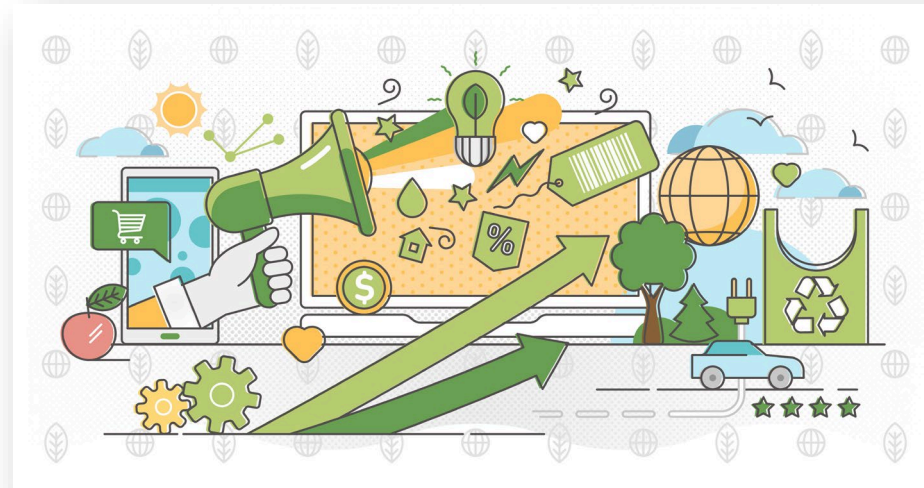
