

QUESTIONNAIRES: PANEL SURVEY ON THE IMPACT OF TRADING APPS ON INVESTMENT AND RISK BEHAVIOR

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Abstract

This document contains the respective questionnaire of three panel survey waves on the impact of trading apps on the investment and risk behavior of Neobroker users.

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Survey questionnaires

A Questionnaire - Panel survey wave 1

The following questionnaire is a translation of the original questionnaire of the first panel survey wave, which was asked in German. This section contains questions of the questionnaire posed to Neobroker users. As it was first necessary to differentiate whether a participant currently uses a Neobroker, there were classification questions, which are also shown. As not all participants were Neobroker users, there were also questions for the groups of former Neobroker users and Neobroker usage planners.
