The review will be performed electronically! Individual time slots will be communicated after registration period. Unfortunately, due to the expected number of registrations, we will not be able to consider any personal preferences for time slots!

An obliging registration for the review is mandatory. Please send a registration mail to our Secretary's office (<u>statistik@unitrier.de</u>).

Registration period ends on 9th November 2021 at 10:00 a.m. Due to organisational reasons, we cannot accept any participants after this deadline!

Furthermore, you will not get access to your electronic exam if you are not registered, as your accounts will not be activated!

IMPORTANT: you need your personal password which you used for the electronic exam in August in order to be able to review your exam (as we told you on the examination day). For privacy reasons you had to change the original password indicated on the sheet "Erklärung zur E-Klausur".

The review of your exam allows you to look into your results concerning achieved points and evaluation. You are NOT allowed to write down or take photos of the content!

During the review, we will not answer to questions concerning content and evaluation of the individual exams.

Corona Guidelines:

- 3G-rules apply for your participation in the exam review! This means that vaccinated and recovered persons have access only. Those students who are not vaccinated must present an antigen test (valid for 24 hours) or else a PCR test (valid for 48 hours).
- Persons who cannot be vaccinated due to reasons they can prove by a certificate are allowed to have themselves tested at a testing station which is available on the campus of Trier University.
 Together with the required certificate these tests are free of charge.

For further information please refer to the university homepage. Persons who cannot show a certificate have to take and pay for a test outside the university.

• Inside all buildings and rooms a facial mask is mandatory (a surgical mask or a mask according to KN95/N95 or FFP 2 standard). There are few **exeptions** if minimum distance is observed (e.g. during examinations, during lectures either on seat or at the lectern).
