ERASMUS+ as program of the EU

ERASMUS+ is an exchange of the EU. It aims to contribute to the "Europe 2020" strategy for growth, jobs, social justice and inclusion, as well as to the objectives of "ET2020", the strategic framework for education in the EU.

Goals (among others)

- Motivation of young people to participate in the democratic life of the EU.
- Promoting adult education.
- Contributing to social inclusion and diversity as well as green and digital transformation.

Facts

- The ERASMUS+ budget in the EU budget is over 26 billion EUR for the years 2021-2027.
- Over 250,000 participants annually.

ERASMUS+ from an employer's perspective

73% rate the **academic competencies** of ERASMUS students **higher** than those of non-mobile students immediately after their return from abroad.

82% also believe that they are **better prepared** for their **future employment and careers**.

82% rate socio-communicative skills, problem-solving skills and leadership skills highly.

Advantages of ERASMUS+ in FB IV

No extension of study time!

- Do not pay study fees abroad.
- Financial support through an ERASMUS+ grant!
- Special rounding of the professional qualification profile and significant increase of entry chances into the profession.
- Acquisition of subject-related foreign language skills.
- Promotion of social competence, tolerance and cultural understanding.

Conditions

- No study fees at the host university.
- Monthly allowance (approx. 400 - 600,- EUR).
- Additional grant for "green travel" and further top-up of EUR 250 per month for students from a non-academic family, students who finance their studies through employment, students with a disability (from GdB 20) or chronic illness and for students with child/children. Alternatively, students with a disability/chronic illness and children can apply to have the actual additional costs covered.
- If applicable, additional BAföG support abroad (up to 300,- EUR no crediting of the ERASMUS grant).
- Crediting of academic achievements at the host university according to prior agreement or binding stipulation in the Learning Agreement.
- Free online language preparation.



Financing

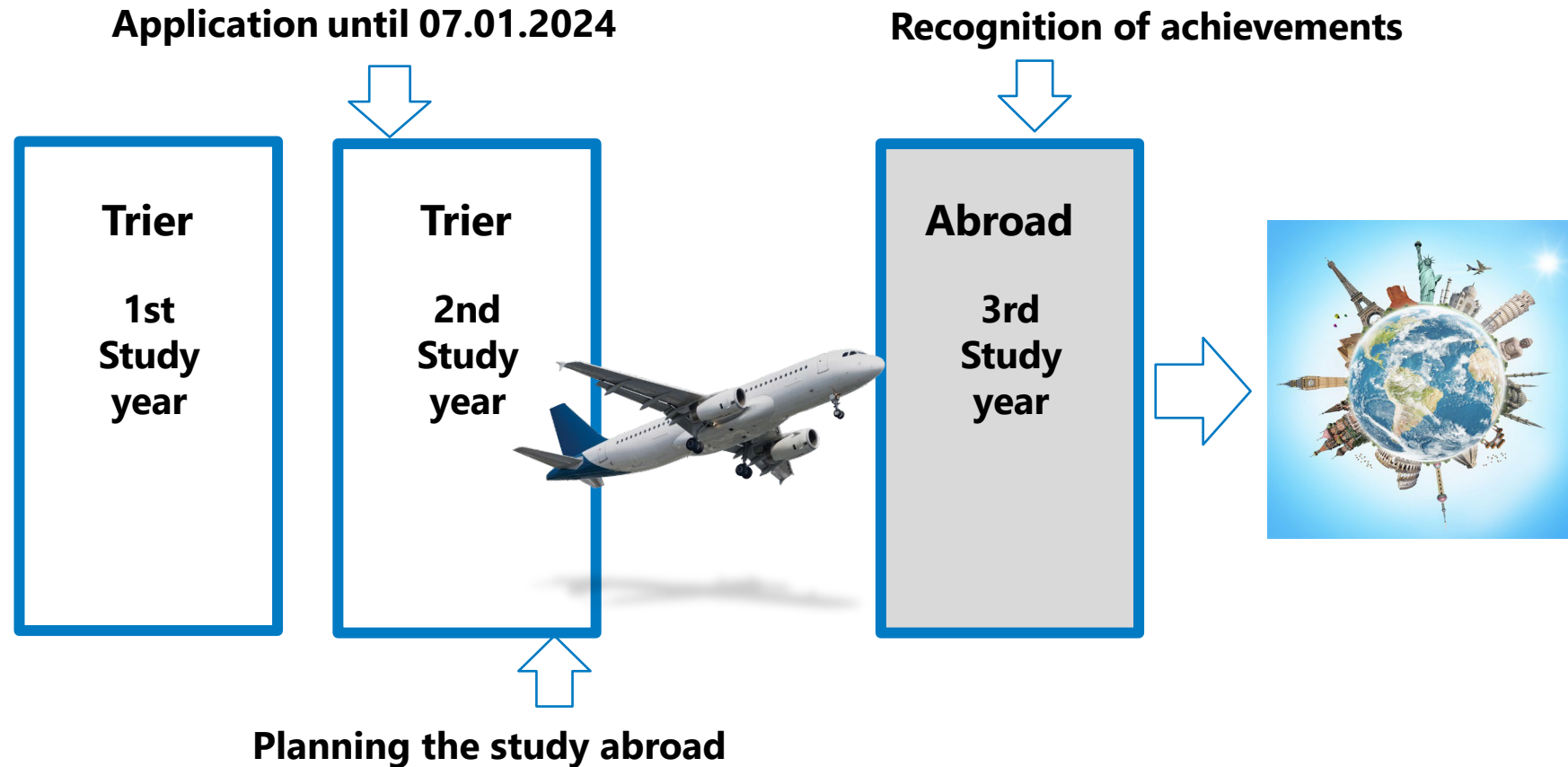
- Group 1 (higher costs of living)
 - Finland, Ireland, Iceland, Luxembourg, Norway, Sweden
- Group 2 (medium cost of living)
 - Austria, Belgium, France, Greece, Italy, Portugal, Spain
- Group 3 (lower cost of living)
 - Estonia, Croatia, Lithuania, Poland, Romania, Slovenia, Turkey, Hungary

Difference between groups, for example:

- Group 1: 600 EUR/month
- Group 2: 540 EUR/month
- Group 3: 490 EUR/month

(actual monthly rates will not be known until June/July 2024).

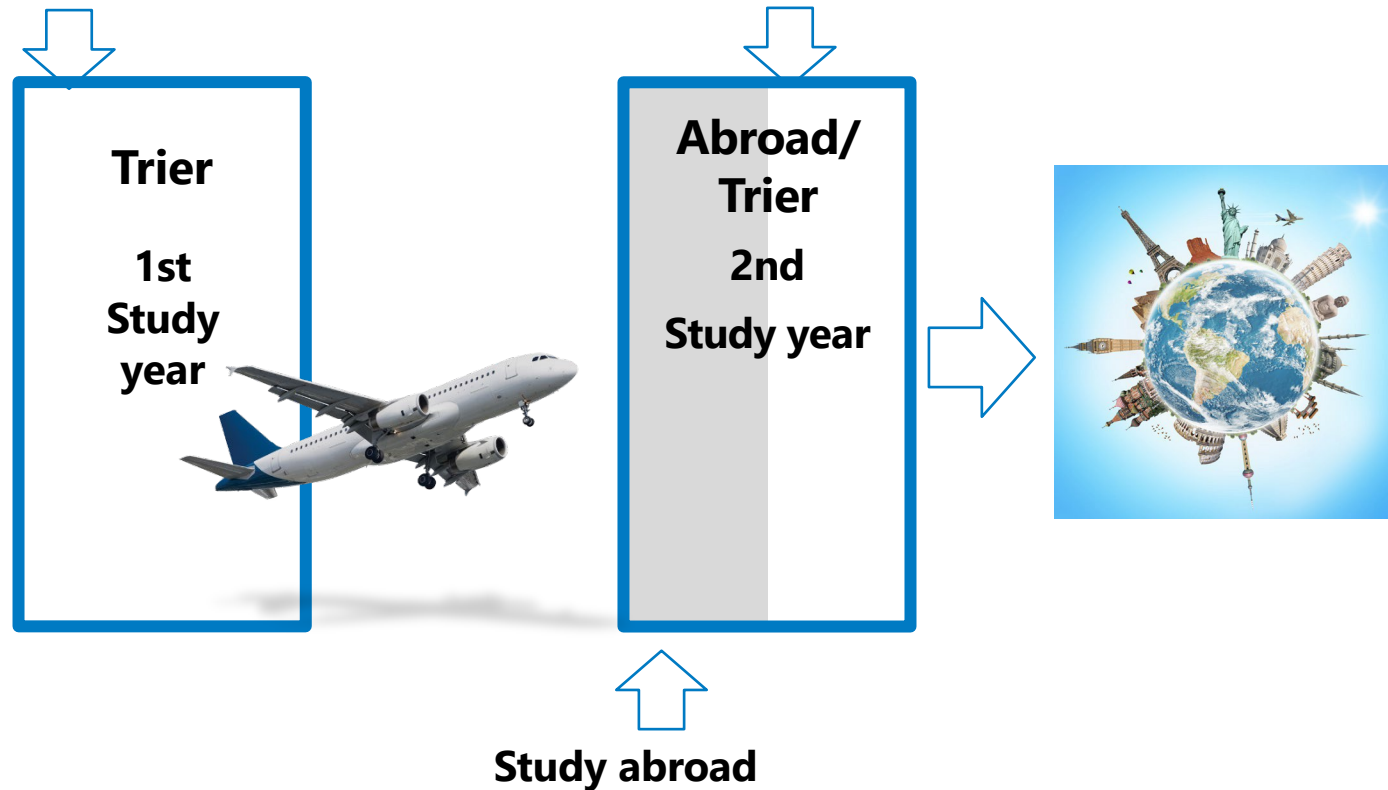
Stay abroad - during the bachelor's degree program

Recognition of achievements



Recognition information

- **Prerequisite** for the study visit:
 - **Successfully completed basic studies** of the 1st and 2nd semester before the start of the study abroad (not required for application!).
- **Recognizable** annual workload.
 - 60 credits per year (for Master 30 credits).
- Recommendation to promote **integration** at the host university.
 - Courses from other areas (languages, sports, culture).

Study achievements abroad are generally recognized or credited to the agreed extent → **No loss of time in your studies!**

Recognizable courses

Bachelor

- Courses from the core area of the field of study
- Specialization in the field of study
- Practice-oriented study project
- Bachelor thesis
- Electives
- Internship

Master

- Specialization modules
- Electives
- If applicable, parts of the research project (depending on the regulation with the respective examiner).

To be considered for recognition

- **Electives** outside of FB IV must be arranged with the **appropriate representatives**.
- **Sociology** as a WISO integration is often not offered at business schools.
- **Course changes** abroad must be discussed with Ms. Jacobs and then **recorded** in the **Learning Agreement 2** in order to be recognized.
- For the **Bachelor thesis, prior consultation with Ms. Jacobs and another professor at Trier University** is necessary.
- Recognition is controlled centrally; arranged **before departure** and applied for and carried out after return (documents available on the homepage). A **separate information** event will be held before departure to discuss course arrangements and recognition.

- **Time of application usually.**

- Bachelor in 3rd semester, then study abroad in 5th and 6th semester.
- Master in 1st semester, then study abroad in 3rd semester.

Application documents

- Application in the following order:
 1. Cover letter/motivational letter (approx. 1 page)
 2. Online form of the International Office → two printouts, signature, passport photo
 3. Program list (BA/MA) → Number desired universities according to preference
 4. Tabular curriculum vitae
 5. Proof of language proficiency (TOEFL, FFA entrance test, IELTS) or information about the date of the language
 6. Certificate of previous examination results → available in PORTA (for Master's degree: copy of Bachelor's degree certificate instead of PORTA printout)
 7. Certificate of enrollment available in PORTA

Application procedure

- Both the **academic performance** at the time of application (we do not update the performance!) and the results of the language test represent only a snapshot!
- A corresponding **language test** on the respective language level must be available at the **time of application**.
- The **academic performance** should at least indicate that the basic studies can be completed in time (i.e. before the start of the stay abroad).
- **ATTENTION**: In case **of failure or non-attendance** (also in case of illness) of the exam, no stay abroad can take place!

Application procedure (6/6)

- Students of Business Administration, Economics and Sociology (including minor subjects) can apply.
 - **Attention:** There are comparatively fewer exchange places in the Master's program.
 - In principle, the exchange is only possible in the **winter semester**.
- **Basic duration**
 - Bachelor: one full academic year (WiSe and SoSe).
 - Master: one semester (WiSe) recommended, but also one year possible.

Dates and language tests

- Language tests are offered by the Language Center on the following dates:
 - English 16.11.2023, 14.12.2023, 11.01.2024
 - Spanish 22.11.2023, 24.01.2024
 - French 10.01.2024, (19.02.2024)
- **Important Infos!**
 - Registration at least one week in advance via PORTA (exception: English online tests)
 - Please adhere to the communicated last possible dates!
 - The result is sent to us directly by the Language Center.
 - Language courses to refresh the language level can also be taken in the summer semester. Please contact the Language Center to register for these courses.
