

Student ID-Card "TUNIKA" and TUKAN Machines

Your student ID-Card, commonly referred to as your "TUNIKA", which you receive after enrolling at Trier University, is a chip-card that has many functions besides just showing your student ID (matriculation) number. This card is used to provide access to various university services (the library, sport and fitness centre, Mensa-cafeterias etc.), payments functions in the TUKAN machines and updating it in the validation machines.

For the digital semester, the most important features are:

- Re-registration – Here you can pay your semester fees and then change the date on your Tunika card by simply inserting it into the validation machine
- ZIMK DocuPRO, Copy, Print and Scan Credit – Here you can add or deduct money from your account, which is used for paying for library copying, printing and scanning services. The money that exist on this account can only be used for the library services
- Tunika – Here you can add or deduct money for your account, which is used for Mensa or the student accommodation washing machines
