- Free electives (Freier Wahlbereich) If your MA-degree programme includes free electives (Freier Wahlbereich), the modules Canadian Studies I and Canadian Studies II will count towards your free electives. - Canadian Studies Certificate

If your degree programme does not include free electives (Freier Wahlbereich), as is the case e.g. with teacher trainings programmes (Lehramt), you can still take classes in *Canadian Studies*.
