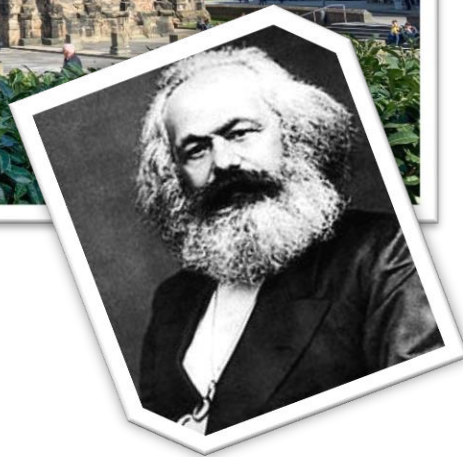
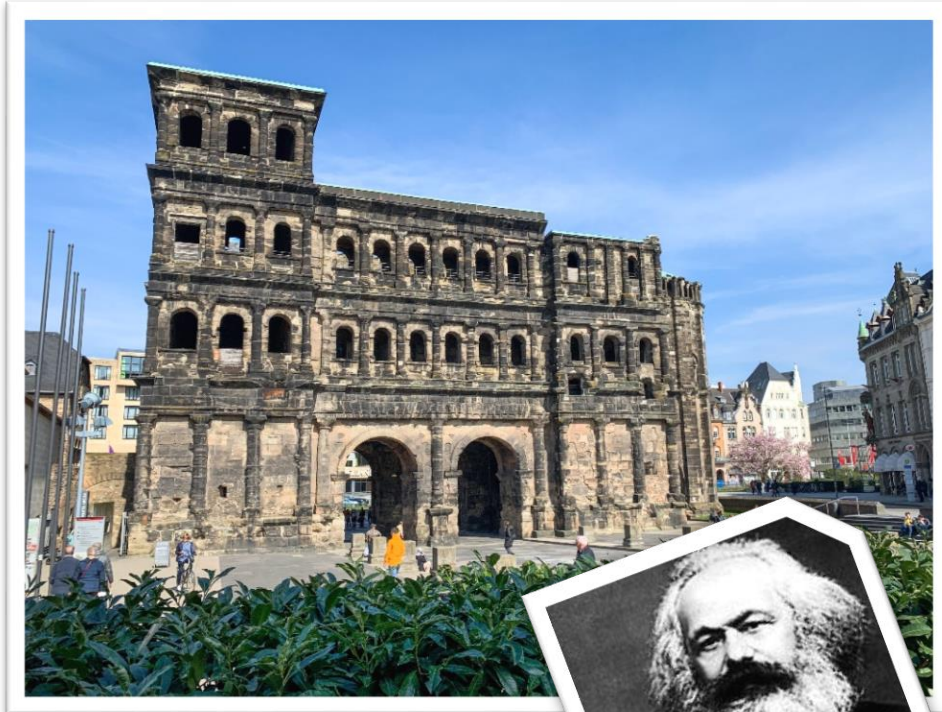

- Germany's oldest city
- UNESCO World Cultural Heritage Site
- About 110.000 inhabitants
- 2 universities with ca. 20.000 students
- Birthplace of Karl Marx

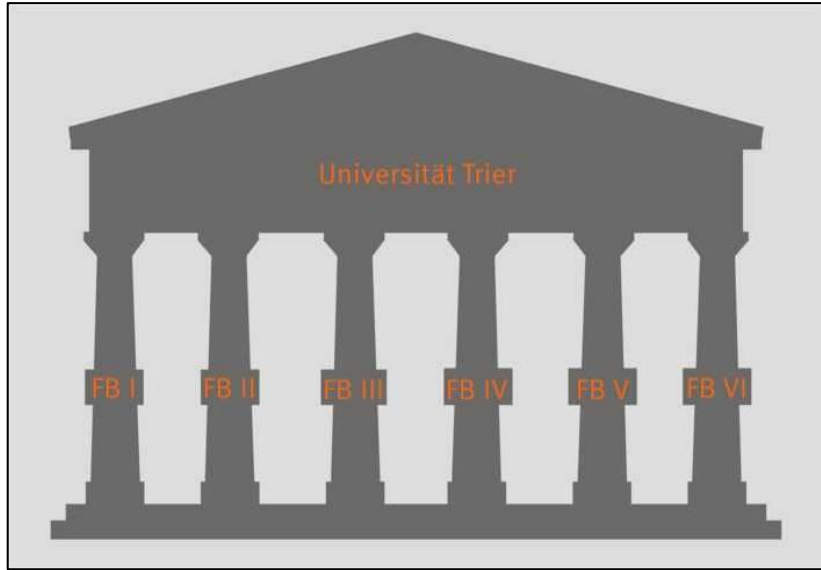


- Roots reaching back to the Middle Ages
- Refounded 1970
- Public university without tuition fees
- More than 30 majors and 150 degree programs
- Library: 2.2 million holdings
- ca. 12.500 students

Campus



- Campus University
- One of Germany's most beautiful campuses
- Most departments are located on a single campus
- Second campus is at a walking distance (ca. 10 minutes)



- Decentralized System
 - 6 Faculties (“Fachbereiche”)
 - + Faculty of Theology
- Focus on the Humanities, Social Sciences and Economics
- Strengthening the Environmental Sciences
- Adding new subjects to canon
