The <u>krAil research group of the professorship</u> conducts research and teaching in the field of *natural language processing*, specifically *machine learning* with and for *human-aligned knowledge representations*. Current focus areas are developing generative agents for simulating human capabilities and behavior, e.g. for researching opinion formation in social networks. Another example is developing aligned AI models without undesired biases, e.g., for reducing the risk of information manipulation in democratic processes.

- A successfully completed university degree (Master's) in Natural Language Processing, Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, Computational Social Science, Computational Media Studies or related.
