CALL FOR ELECTIONS

of the L. Student Parliament

December 04th - December 06th 2023

Campus I – Mensa Foyer and Campus II – Mensa side room (F53)

Application for absentee ballots until November 21st, 2023

All properly registered students of the University of Trier as well as students of the Faculty of Theology who are registered in at least one minor subject at the University of Trier are eligible to vote and to be elected. Voting is only possible in person, not by proxy.

Absentee ballots can be requested until 11:59 pm on Tuesday, November 21st, 2023 from the Election Committee by e-mail. The address needs to be correspondent to the correspondence address according to PORTA.

The student parliament has 25 seats - subject to overhang mandates - 12 of which are allocated via departmental elections. The departmental affiliation for active and passive voting rights is based on the main subject of the 1st degree program. The subject area according to the electoral roll is binding.

The electoral register, in which all eligible voters are listed, can be viewed from Monday, November 13th, 2023, during the office hours of the Electoral Committee in room B15 or on request via University email. Only those listed in this final electoral roll may vote. **Amendments to the electoral roll must be submitted to the Electoral Committee by 6 pm on November 20th, 2023.**

Nominations can be submitted to the Election Committee in room B15 until Wednesday, November 22nd, 2023 at 12pm. The Elections Committee strongly recommends that nominations **be submitted by Monday, November 20th, 2023** to allow for review and correction of nominations by the Elections Committee.

Forms for nominations can be downloaded from the Election Committee website at stupa.uni-trier.de or requested directly from the Election Committee. For each departmental list proposal, a central list proposal of the same name must be submitted. Each central and departmental list requires a supporting signature from a person who is not standing for election or supporting another list. In the case of departmental lists, the signature may only be affixed by a person who belongs to the department according to the electoral roll.

The exact regulations can be found in the election regulations of the student body §§ 18-23. The election regulations are available in room B15 and can be viewed at stupa.uni-trier.de.

Election campaigning, in particular poster campaigning, is only permitted after being instructed by the Election Committee on Thursday, November 23rd, 2023. **Lists that wish to be informed about and participate in the election advertising offers of the election committee must have registered by November 20th, 2023 at the latest.**

The ballots will be counted on Wednesday, December 06th, 2023, starting at 5pm in room C2.
