





# Exchange programs (Austauschprogramme)

- Exchange programmes always go in two directions: Universities receive students from a partner university and in return send their own students to this partner. Tuition fees are mutually waived.
- In addition to the academic aspects, cultural exchange also plays an important role.
- Achievements at the host university can usually be recognised at the home university.
- Exchange students are always ambassadors for their home country and their home university.



# Study Stays



## Duration:

usually 2 semesters (9-10 months)

1 semester: application for one semester is also possible if the reasons are given.

## Financing:


A: [ISEP, Clark, Hamline](#): No tuition fees at the host university AND **free accommodation and meals**, but **own contribution of 5.000€** (for one semester **3.500€**) in advance

B: [Georgetown University](#): No tuition fees at the host university, **a scholarship of ~11.000\$**, self-financed accommodation and meals


C: [All other programs](#): No tuition fees at the host university and self-financed accommodation and meals

### **Bilateral Exchange with the University of Manitoba**

# Teaching assistantships

## Target groups:


Students studying English, German as a foreign language and/or German studies in their Bachelor's or Master's degree program

You should have completed the **basic modules of DAF (Deutsch als Fremdsprache)** by the start of the stay; Interested students without a DaF degree should be ready to acquire the basics of DaF in the semester(s) before the stay.

## Duration:

one academic year (not only 1 semester!)





## Teaching assistantships

*Collaboration including teaching in the German Department of Colleges; taking usually one course per semester from the university's range of courses*

# Teaching Assistantship

## Duration:

2 semesters (9-10 months)

1 semester: not possible

## Financing:

- exemption from tuition fees at the host university
- free accommodation
- meal plan
- monthly grant


<b>name</b>	Texas Christian University
<b>location</b>	Fort Worth, Texas
<b>study cycle</b>	Bachelor and Master
<b>study options</b>	attendance of 1 class (3 credits)
<b>costs</b>	Visa costs, travel expenses, personal needs
<b>scholarship benefits</b>	free accomodation and board, tuition fee waver, sports, health service, transport ticket, funding: ~ 1.500\$ /semester
<b>job description</b> <b>Teaching Assistant</b>	teaching assistance; conversations with students; German Stammtisch once a week; peer tutoring programme; organisation of events for the „German House“, field trips
<b>accommodation</b>	dormitory (German House)

# Teaching Assistantship

<b>name</b>	Gardner-Webb-University
<b>location</b>	Boiling Springs, North Carolina
<b>study cycle</b>	Master (and possibly Bachelor)
<b>study options</b>	2-3 classes
<b>costs</b>	Visa costs, travel expenses, personal needs
<b>scholarship benefits</b>	Free accomodation and board (women's dorm), scholarship, access to rental cars
<b>Job description Teaching Assistant</b>	Taking over of beginner's classes and conversation (under guidance)
<b>accomodation</b>	Women's dormitory

1. Registration via "**Online Application form**"
2. Upload your documents via the **Upload-Platform**
3. Application **deadline** usually mid/end of November
4. **Incomplete** applications are sorted out!
5. **Review** of application documents (board of international affairs)
6. **Selection interview** at the beginning of December
7. **Acceptance/rejection letters** before Christmas
8. **Application** procedure at the host university (from January)
9. Application for **visa** (Mai to July)
- 10. Departure** for the stay abroad in the middle/end of August

For the **teaching assistantships**, the selection interviews may be conducted separately from the other programs by a smaller committee.

After you have been selected, you will be **well prepared and advised** by the International Office and former exchange participants for your stay abroad!




