From 7 p.m. onwards, curated by Sound Diplomacy and provided in collaboration with United We Stream and Arte, the second part of the celebrations will be broadcasted live from the Berlin Kulturbrauerei under the title "United We Stream: Canada Day live from Frannz Club". Among the sophisticated musical line-up of Canadians living in Berlin, we are excited to present D. Tiffany, DJ Kirby (Blue Hawaii), Magic Island and Nathan Micay.

"United We Stream: Canada Day live from Frannz Club" is an online event in solidarity with the Berlin local club scene, an important springboard for emerging Canadian artists in Europe. Donations are welcome at http://uws.betterplace.org and benefit cultural institutions in need. Of the donations, eight percent will go to the Civil Sea Rescue Foundation.
