Outline:

"Studying Canada," professor Nadine Fabbi from the University of Washington claims, "allows our students to get to know themselves better as Americans, including their government, their social values, their ideologies, etc." Is there a similar value in bringing Canada into the European classroom? We want to pursue this question by approaching this multicultural North American nation from literary, political, geographical and socio-political perspectives. As we focus on representative aspects of Canada's intercultural past and present, we will also ask which methods and media are useful and available for communicating the respective content in the classroom. Which information elements can better help us in understanding Canada while fostering a comparison with Germany and Europe? Our trilingual one-day workshop seeks to engage in a practically oriented information exchange (e.g., lists of literature / media recommendations will be provided): Our central idea is to combine content-based presentations with consecutive discussions about general 'teachability'; in that process also drawing from your personal experience, we aim at pooling suggestions for further topics and alternative approaches in an interdisciplinary spirit. We would cordially like to invite teachers interested in integrating Canada into the 'intercultural' classroom, both in and beyond the subjects of English and French. While participation is free of charge, a registration (deadline 14 April 2008) is required.
